School Admission Policy

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All students regardless of religion, nationality, culture, ethnicity and language will be able to participate in our classes which implement the IB Diploma programme.

Gökkuşığı College aims to create an effective, friendly and welcoming, healthy and protective, and gender-sensitive environment for all learners; to create a culture of collaboration; to increase the participation and to differentiate the teaching, the learning and the assessment in the school and to increase the student diversity at school by providing bursaries.

Gökkuşığı College guarantees 50% scholarship for those who get between 400- 450 points in LGS exam (national exam conducted) at the end of Grade 8 in middle school and want to study in the IB programme starting from the foundation or year grade 9 according to their level of English; our school guarantees 100% scholarship for those who get between 450 - 500 points and who want to study in the IB programme in high school starting from the foundation or year grade 9 according to their level of English.. The maximum point is 500 in these exams. The rates of scholarship may be changed in case of the changes in point system. If the exam is repealed, the school will determine the rates of scholarship by making its own written and oral exams.

Students of Gökkuşığı Anatolian High School who would like to switch to IB Diploma programme after grade 9 or 10 will be provided 100 percent scholarship if their average grades are between 4.50 and 5.00 but if their academic background and English level is enough by the final decision of the DP coordinator.

Gökkuşığı College works hard to start collaboration and has relations with some international foundations to provide scholarships and accommodation to international students in order to form international IB classes.

Gökkuşığı College has right to change the admission criteria and bursary rates to ensure the diversity in the school.
